Student Achievement/Instruction/Curriculum/Initiatives

i-Ready Diagnostic Data – The *i-Ready Diagnostic* is an adaptive assessment that identifies students' strengths and weaknesses, measures growth, and supports data-driven differentiated instruction. It provides comprehensive insight into student learning across K-12 skills to help you meet the needs of all students.

Tier 1 (green): students placed one grade level below, on grade level or above grade level

Tier 2 (yellow): students placed two grade levels below


Tier 3 (red): students placed three or more grade levels below

- The difference in Year-to-Year Tier percentages is attributed to loss of learning since spring and standards not yet taught.
- Beginning week of October 5, teachers and staff will host family/student data chats to review the diagnostic data and create learning goals
- All instructional, support and leadership staff, including specials, will be assigned an advisory group of up to 14 students. The purpose is to build relationships and provide academic support.

Students Assessed/Total: 722/857


Overall Placement




Math 2020 – does not include Kindergarten






<mark>Math 2019</mark> – K-8th

Grading per FCS (received September 25)

As part of an ongoing follow up to Universal Remote Learning, an update on grading practices will be shared today. This update included a staff recommendation to establish a more uniform grading practices across the district. This guidance is an update to the Universal Remote Learning grading guidance, effective September 21 (Phase 3). This grading guidance will end at the end of the 2020 semester.

The following changes will be in effect moving forward for every school while in URL:

• Quizzes are to be considered as summative assessments

- Students will have one (1) attempt to redo/retake an assessment
- Students who achieve a 79 or less (less than an 80) are eligible for a redo/retake.
- Students can earn up to an 89 on a replacement grade on a redo/retake
- Student redo/retakes must be completed 10 school days prior to the end of the semester.
