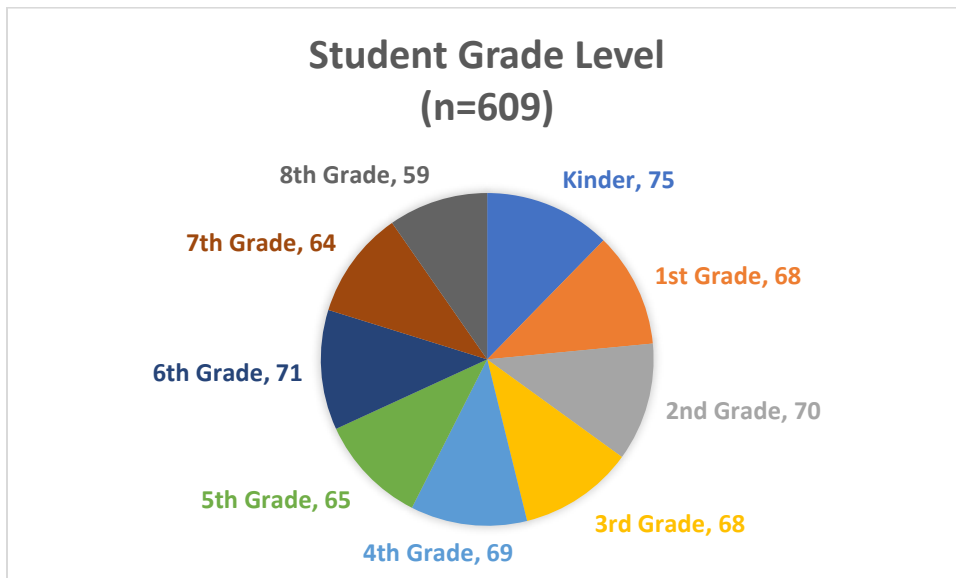

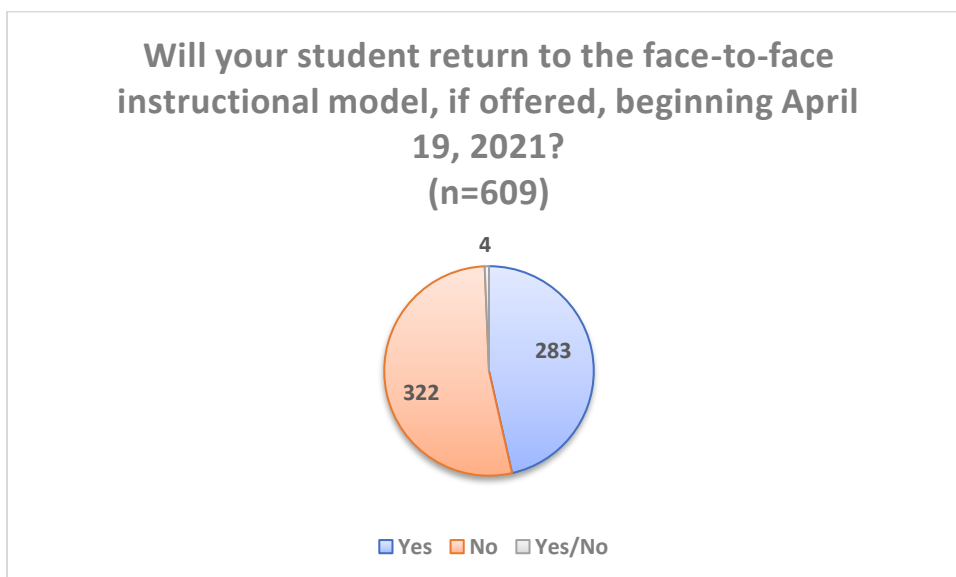

Q1: Student Current Grade Level (n=609)

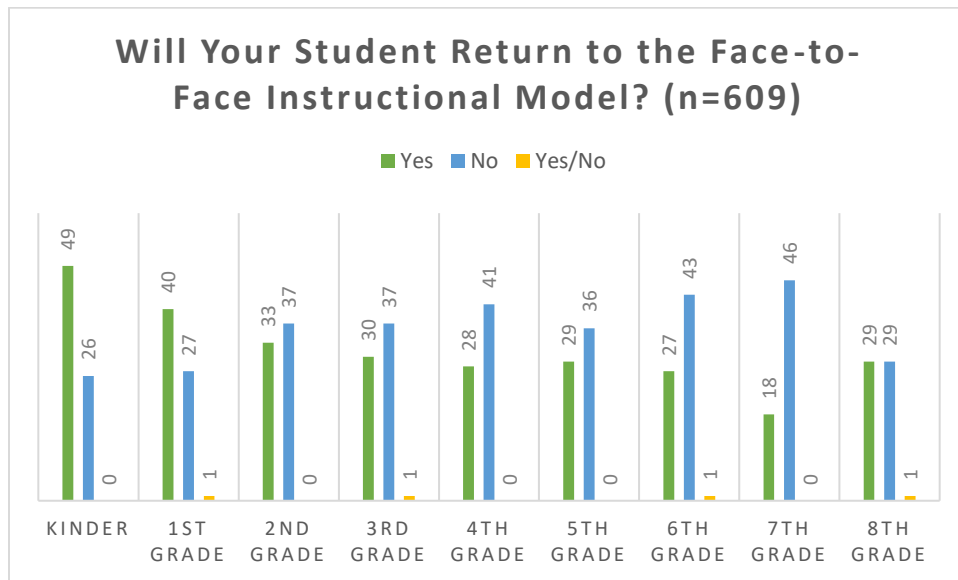


Q2: Will your student return to the face-to-face instructional model, if offered, beginning April 19, 2021? (n=609)

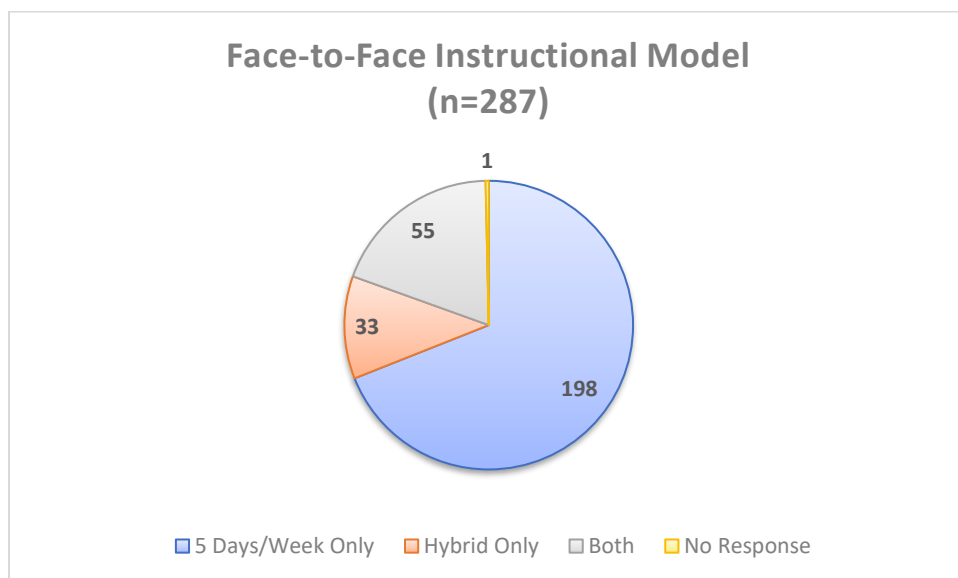

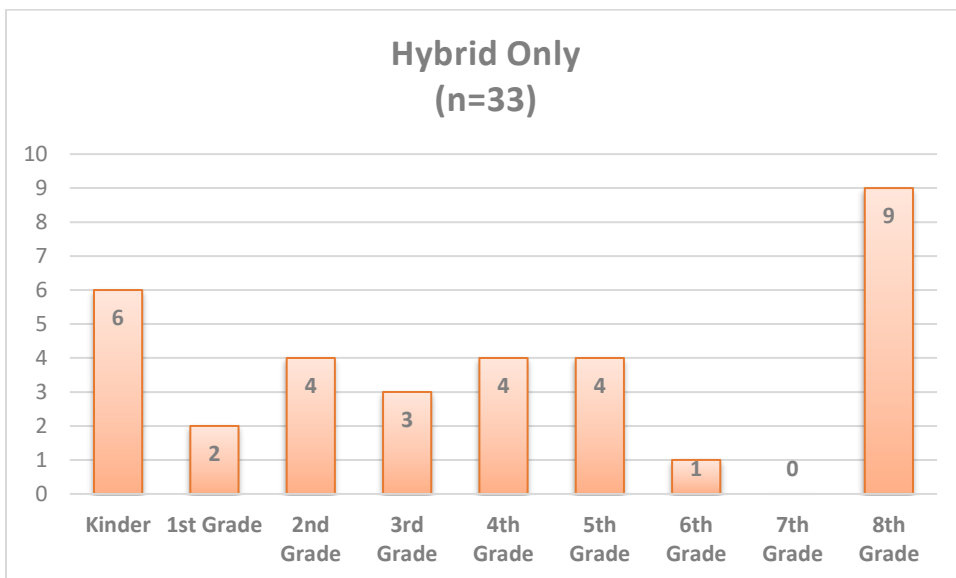
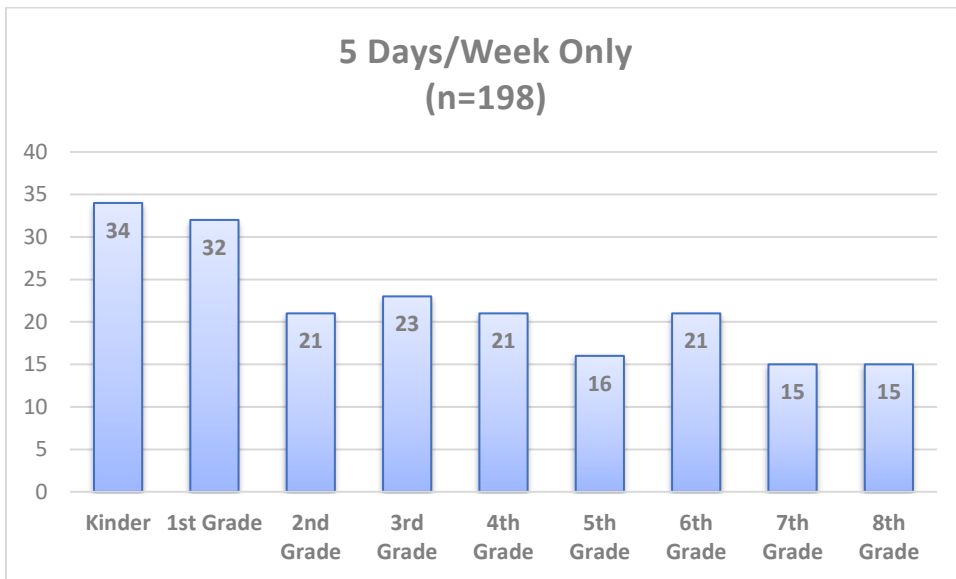
Q2: Will your student return to the face-to-face instructional model, if offered, beginning April 19, 2021 (by grade level)? (n=609)



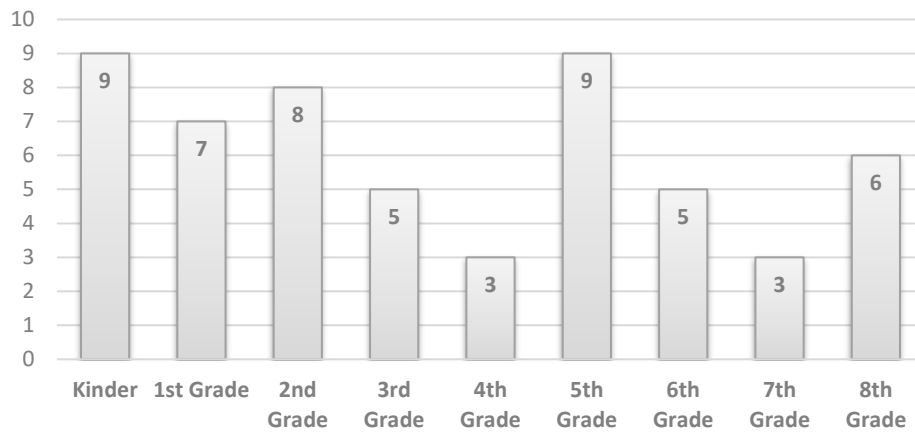
Q3: If yes, select the following face-to-face instructional models that can accommodate your household? Depending upon your preference, select one or both options.



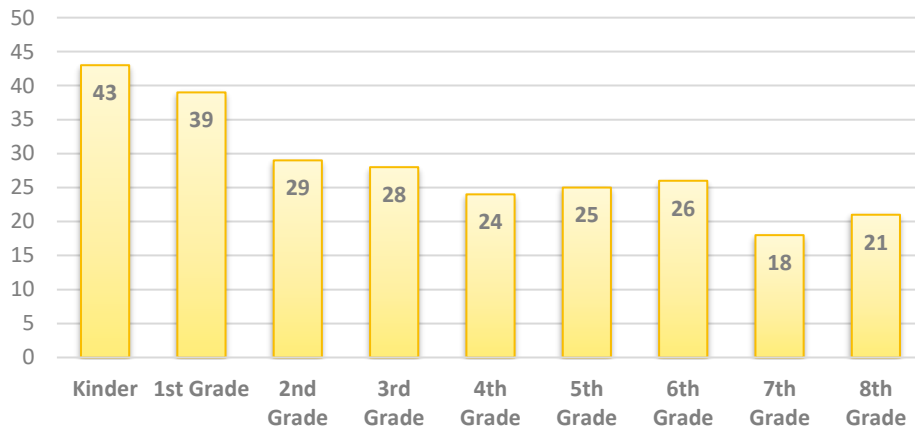
Instructional Models by Grade Level



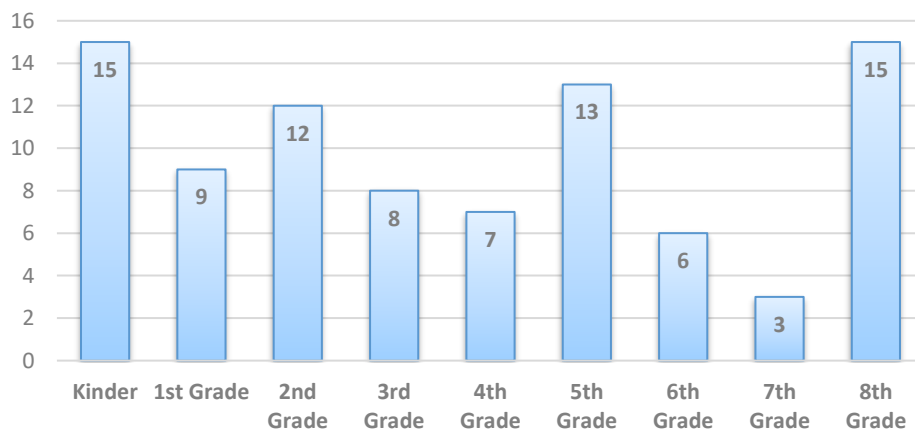
F2F & Hybrid (both)

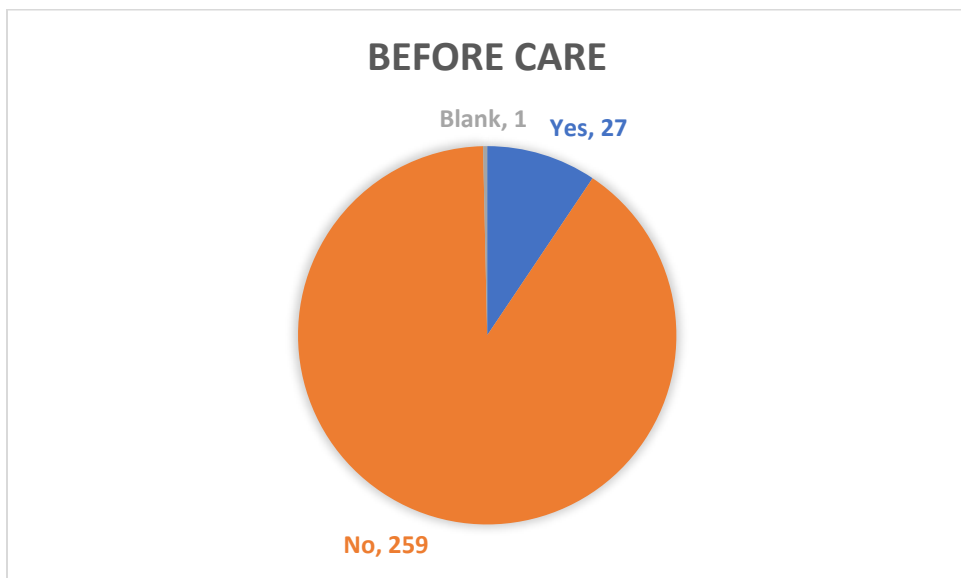
F2F & Both Combined
(n=253)



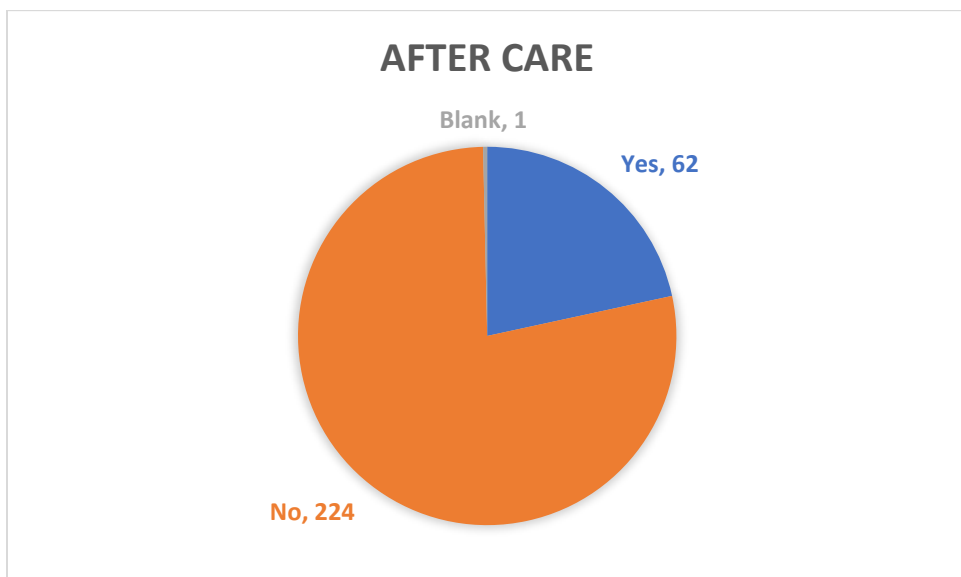
Hybrid & Both Combined
