

# 4. 2019-2020 School Calendar

**CALENDAR PROPOSAL**: At September 10th board work session, staff submitted item 7.03, <u>2019-20 School Year Calendar</u> <u>Revision</u>, which is a plan to address safety and security at our schools during state-wide elections. As you are aware, the high-volume participation of our public during state-wide elections carries the potential for increased security concerns and disruption to instruction on those days. Therefore, staff recommended that the Board of Education make all <u>state-wide</u> election days <u>digital learning days</u>. This would apply to this school year as well as future school years.

By utilizing digital learning, students will be able to maintain their focus on instruction while not on campus. These days would be regular workdays for employees. This approach allows staff to participate in high quality professional development. The two days in the current school year impacted by this proposal would be <u>April 21, 2020</u>, and <u>May 19, 2020</u>. The adjusted assessment calendar, <u>if adopted</u>, for end of grade milestones tests and final exam week is attached. The last day of IB exams is impacted, and a separate plan will be developed with those schools.

Staff also recommended that the March 13th work day remain as it was originally published (as a workday).
